- Class 202**      **1<sup>st</sup> Pony of Show Hunter Type** – mare or gelding not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year. Snaffle Bridles only, no cantering allowed except for individual performances. Ponies must leave ring at walk or trot.

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (Nations Cup, World European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Junior and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/ International Team Events and European Championships in the last 5 years are not eligible. (Excluding Veteran Teams). 1<sup>st</sup> 6 to qualify. Qualification will not pass down the line and qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. Regional points will be awarded in riders own region league.

Horses must exceed 148cms or if under, **MUST** not to have been entered in any Junior classes during the current year. Riders 14yrs and over on Jan 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Horses in this class, not eligible for Class 260b.
